
## **Obtaining Licenses and Activating Semantix Roaming Studio**

(this guide applies to Roaming Studio 1.0, 1.1 and 2.0)

Roaming Studio Licenses are node-locked licenses with only one instance allowed to run per node. The "trial" version which you download from <a href="https://www.tapeditor.com">www.tapeditor.com</a> contains all the functionality of the activated product. However, the "save" button is disabled. This is the only piece of functionality that is blocked (locked) with respect to the activated version. To enable the "save" button you just need to activate your installation of the "trial" version. You don't have to download and / or install any other binary. After activation, the "trial" version upgrades to the fully working, activated version.

During the evaluation period you will notice that every time you launch Roaming Studio, the following dialog pops up:



Activation Dialog


If you wish to continue evaluating the product just press "continue" (the "enter application" radio box is the default option). Once you are done evaluating the product and wish to activate it, you must install the product to the real production machines (which may be different from the evaluation machines). To do that you do not need to download any additional binary. Just use the "trial" binary you downloaded if you still have it available. If it's no longer available download a new trial binary and install Roaming Studio on the production machines.

Launch the installed applications on every production machine and write down on a sheet of paper the site code / MID pairs. These numbers uniquely identify the machine and will need to be sent via email to: <a href="machine-activate@tapeditor.com">activate@tapeditor.com</a> to obtain the unlocking codes.

Be sure to keep these activation codes for future reference (for instance, you'll need them in case you wish to transfer the licenses to another machine).

Once you get the activation codes, simply re-launch the applications (close any previous running instance) and:

- 1. select the radio box "Unlock application"
- 2. enter the activation code
- 3. press "Continue"
- ... as depicted in the following screenshot:
