
Transferring Semantix Roaming Studio Licenses

Roaming Studio Licenses are node-locked licenses. This guide describes the procedure to use when you wish to transfer one such node-locked license ("old" installation or node) to another machine ("new" installation or node).

In general transferring a license consists of two parts:

- deactivating the "old" installation by removing the license from the "old" node (remember to keep the removal code you'll be given).
- installing a trial version of Roaming Studio on the "new" node and activating it.

The procedure depends on which Roaming Studio version you have. Select Help/About from the menu, and look at the dialog box that comes up:




If the version reported is 1.1.x or later, follow the steps described in "Transferring Roaming Studio versions 1.1.x and later". Otherwise, follow the steps described in "Transferring Roaming Studio versions 1.0.x".

Transferring Roaming Studio versions 1.0.x

To transfer a Roaming Studio license from an existing to a new node, you will need to:


- 1. find the activation code of the node-locked license (it was mailed to you at the time of the original activation and you should have kept it as per the activation instructions)
- 2. download the deactivation program: www.tapeditor.com/deactivation.zip
- 3. unzip it and copy it on the machine whose copy of the Roaming Studio you wish to deactivate.
- 4. run deactivation.exe

5. the "Semantix Roaming Studio Deactivation" dialog pops up:



6. enter the old activation code:





7. select the radio box "Remove license":

- 8. press "Continue >>"
- 9. you are prompted to confirm that you indeed wish to permanently remove the Roaming Studio license from that node:



- 10.press "Yes" if you indeed wish to permanently remove the Roaming Studio license from that node. VERY IMPORTANT: Restraint from pressing the "Enter" or "Return" key twice as you will need to note down the number that appears, only once, on the next screen.
- 11.the removal code appears. **DO NOT PRESS "OK" BEFORE YOU COPY the removal code**:




- 12. write down the removal code or if you prefer, select it and copy it into the clipboard.
- 13.at this point you have successfully removed the Semantix Roaming Studio license from your old node. Note that the Semantix Roaming Studio itself is not removed, just deactivated. A locked version of the Roaming Studio will remain which you may activate (if you so chose) in the future.
- 14.to install an activated Roaming Studio to a new node, follow the instructions on the "Activating Roaming Studio" guide (without the paying part of course) and remember to sent the removal code along with the [Site code / MID] of the new machine to activate@tapeditor.com
- 15. We will then respond with an email containing the activation code for the new machine.


Transferring Roaming Studio versions 1.1.x and later

To transfer a Roaming Studio version 1.1.x and later license, from an existing to a new node, you will need to:

- 1. find the activation code of the node-locked license (it was mailed to you at the time of the original activation and you should have kept it as per the activation instructions)
- 2. toggle Scroll-Lock at your keyboard (in most keyboards this will also toggle a LED):




- 3. launch Roaming Studio
- 4. the "Semantix Roaming Studio Deactivation" dialog pops up:



5. enter the old activation code:



6. select the radio box "Remove license":




7. press "Continue >>"

8. you are prompted to confirm that you indeed wish to permanently remove the Roaming Studio license from that node:



- 9. press "Yes" if you indeed wish to permanently remove the Roaming Studio license from that node. VERY IMPORTANT: Restraint from pressing the "Enter" or "Return" key twice as you will need to note down the number that appears, only once, on the next screen.
- 10.the removal code appears. **DO NOT PRESS "OK" BEFORE YOU COPY the removal code**:



- 11. write down the removal code or if you prefer, select it and copy it into the clipboard.
